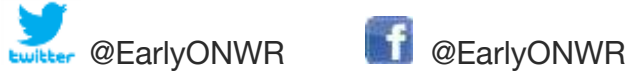

- Health and Wellness** Whether you are looking to stay for the day or just a couple of hours, your family is welcome to bring a meal or snack to share together.  
  
We try to minimize illness by practicing good hygiene and disinfecting toys regularly. Children who are too ill to play, to attend childcare, or to attend school are too ill to come to the EarlyON Child and Family Centres. We follow Public Health guidelines and ask that you return to the centre after he/she is free of diarrhea and/or vomiting for 24 hours. Many babies and very young children attend the EarlyON Child and Family Centres and these children play and learn by mouthing objects. If you or your child show signs of high fever, vomiting, diarrhea or other contagious illness you will be asked to leave the centre until you are well.  
  
We strive to be Scent-free, Nut-free And Sesame-free. Many people attending our programs have severe allergies. Help keep them safe.
- Programming Outdoors** Programming can be held out in the Outdoor Learning Area
- Footwear** For safety reasons - we recommend dry, indoor footwear.
- Stroller Parking** Stroller Parking is located by the gym. We ask that you leave your stroller there when visiting our centre. This helps keep our floors dry and our Exits clear.
